Dear Parents and Carers

We are expecting warm weather next week (22nd–26th June) and, in response to the higher temperatures, we will be making a temporary adjustment to our school uniform expectations.

On Monday, students may wear the following:

- Summer polo shirt (as normal)
- PE sports shorts only or school trousers/skirts (**leggings are not permitted**)
- Black socks (as normal)
- Trainers

While we are adapting our uniform requirements to ensure students remain comfortable in the warm weather, all other school expectations remain unchanged. Students should continue to bring all required equipment to school, including bags, pencil cases, and any other essential learning materials.

Experience shows that changes to routines can sometimes lead to variations in behaviour or uniform standards. We therefore ask for your support in ensuring that students adhere to the expectations outlined above.

Should we observe inappropriate modifications to the approved uniform or a decline in standards of behaviour and preparedness, then as normal, our school climate for learning policy will be applied. In addition, the school reserves the right to reinstate our usual summer uniform at any point.
