Dear Parents/Carers

Following my earlier letter, I am writing to inform you about arrangements for the day of industrial action by the National Education Union on Wednesday 15th and Thursday 16th March. As you are aware, this is a dispute between the government and the NEU over teachers' pay and school funding at a national level.

I am sorry to inform you that Sturminster Newton High School will be closed to all students on 15th and 16th March and we are asking you not to send your child to school on these days. We have informed the bus companies and Dorset Transport.

I have not taken this decision lightly. Our priority is to ensure a safe and secure environment for students and based on the information available we would be unable to provide this with the staff we have on site and available to work.

Staff who are not taking industrial action will provide work on google classroom so students will be able to log on from home. Students should check google classroom for work and live lesson links for each lesson. I would ask that all students check google classroom and complete work set. Work will not be set by staff taking industrial action.
